Mori Town Household Waste Sorting Guide

Business waste (waste generated from business activities by companies or sole proprietors) cannot be disposed of at local collection stations.

Burnable Waste	Burnable Waste Food waste, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Always dispose of waste at the designated collection date, time, and place. Thoroughly drain water from food waste before placing it in a bag. Up to two bags per disposal is allowed. During periods when waste volume is higher than usual, such as the year-end and New Year holidays, please take measures, for example, please prioritize disposing of food waste and heavily soiled waste to manage the increased volume.

Recyclables	① Cans <small>(Light blue containers (large))</small> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For used oil cans and paint cans, wipe the contents clean and dispose of them according to "② Metal Items and Household Appliances". Place nails and screws in a lidded steel can, such as a tea can. Large metal products must be brought in person to the "Chuen Wide Area Bulky Waste Disposal Facility." Remove lithium-ion batteries, dry cell batteries, and other batteries before disposal. If you cannot remove them, dispose of them according to "⑥ Lithium Ion Batteries". Dispose of metal caps as "② Metal Items and Household Appliances". Dispose of plastic caps as "⑦ Plastic Containers and Packaging". Dispose of bottles that cannot be washed clean, bottles whose contents have hardened, broken bottles, and commercially available ointment bottles as "① Debris". Rinse lightly before disposal. Labels do not need to be removed before disposal. Dispose of plastic bottles besides PET bottles as "⑦ Plastic Containers and Packaging". Fluorescent lights should be placed in the paper cover that came with them when they were purchased (to prevent bursting). Do not place lithium-ion batteries or rechargeable batteries here. Dispose of lithium-ion batteries and rechargeable electronic devices here. Remove stickers such as price tags as much as possible. Make sure to remove any dirt before disposal. If the dirt cannot be removed, the item cannot be recycled. Please dispose of it as "burnable waste." Remove stickers such as price tags as much as possible. Make sure to remove any dirt before disposal. If the dirt cannot be removed, the item cannot be recycled. Please dispose of it as "burnable waste." Limited to items made entirely of plastic. Items collected in the community include plastic hangers, washbasins, plastic tableware, etc. If you are unsure about how to dispose of plastic products, please use the designated collection points held twice a month. Put oil in a transparent or translucent plastic cooking oil bottle or PET bottle, with the lid tightly closed. When disposing of more than a container full, bring it to a disposal facility yourself. Remove the gas first, then put in an empty can or the like.
	② Metal Items and Household Appliances <small>(Light blue containers (large))</small> Items larger than a container (75 cm x 50 cm x 40 cm) should be taken directly to the Chuen Wide Area Bulky Waste Disposal Facility. 	
	③ Glass Bottles <small>(Including beer bottles and 1.8 liter bottles)</small> <small>(Light blue containers (small))</small> White/clear: Juice bottles, Jam jars, Condiment bottles, Cosmetic bottles Brown: Beer bottles, 1.8 liter bottles, Energy drink bottles Others: Juice bottles, Liquor bottles, Cosmetic bottles *Dispose of all bottles that are neither clear nor brown as "Other".
